

# ADULT REQUIREMENTS

## BIBLE CAMP 2021



We are so excited for you to partner with us and to be able to offer a Bible Camp this year at Glen Lake Camp and Retreat Center. Below are a few talking points and frequently asked questions when it comes to adults at Bible Camp.

Each church sending children to Bible Camp will provide one MinistrySafe certified gender specific adult per seven campers. This means if you send 13 boys and 6 girls, then your church should provide 2 male adults and 1 female adult. You must provide adult volunteers for your campers to attend Bible Camp.

All adults must be MinistrySafe certified through their local church. Your church will need to provide a MinistrySafe compliance form (found on the Bible Camp website) 2-weeks prior to Bible Camp. Completed forms are due on October 22, 2021.

### **Who is responsible for my camper's medication?**

Each church is responsible for your camper's medication.

### **How do adults register?**

Adults register in the same place as campers.

### **How old does an adult have to be?**

Adults must be 18+ to count in the MinistrySafe ratio listed above.

### **Do I have to sleep in a cabin?**

Yes, adults are in the cabins with the campers. Adults will be in the cabin with the campers of the same gender. You will be responsible for the campers from your church. Your group may be combined with another church for sleeping accommodations if necessary.

### **I eat a special diet, can you accommodate for my meals?**

We try very hard to work with dietary needs of all campers and volunteers at Glen Lake Camp. Reach out to us and let us know how we can help.
